"The House of Romance" in Târgoviște



The establishment of the "House Romance" in Târgovişte - a unique museum space in Romania - by the "Citadel of Romance" Cultural Association Târgoviște, under the patronage of the European Federation of UNESCO Clubs and Associations is one of the most remarkable arguments with which we nationally and internationally, the Romance music as a genre of national cultural heritage, for the purpose of its inscription in the Representative List of UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage. The "House of

Romance" Museum is part of The National Museum Complex of "The Princely Court" of Târgovişte, subordinated to the County Council of Dâmboviţa.

The idea of establishing the "House of Romance" belongs to the president and founder of the "Citadel of Romance" Cultural Association in Târgovişte, mr. Teodor Vasiliu, Ph.D. in History, author of the "History of the Golden Chrysanthemum" monography, a passionate researcher of the Romance genre and musical phenomenon in Târgovişte and the owner of an impressive personal collection of documents regarding the Romance and the "Golden Chrysanthemum" National Festival. Through this approach, the public has the opportunity to enter the fascinating world of the Romance, which has been celebrated by great singers, composers, poets, actors and remarkable personalities of Romania's national culture and also by valuable artists from the international scene.
